Claim 2 is rejected on the grounds of being indefinite in the recital of "or nord in line 7.

Claim 2, line 12, the second "said" occurring at the end of the line should be canceled.

Claims 3, 4 are rejected for the same reasons as claim 2.

Claim 8 is rejected on the grounds of failing to particularly moint out and to distinctly claim the invention.

Claim 9 is rejected on the grounds of setting forth an unpatentable method. The steps recited appear to be no more than the normal function of the apparatus.

Claims 1, 5, 6, 7 appear at present to be allowable.

This is in response to Patent Office action of 16 October 1943 in the above identified application.

The case is being prosecuted under the three-year rule.

Please amend as indicated below.

IN THE SPECIFICATION:

Page 5, line 24 - Insert the following paragraph:

description calls for the transmission of a signal when one only of the coils 14 and 15 is energized, the apparatus will function just as well and achieve just as great privacy if rearranged slightly, as by giving an opposite bias, a normal closed condition, to switch 24-25. In such case, of course, a signal will be transmitted whenever coils 14-15 are in the same condition instead of when they are in different conditions.

REMARKS

With regard to Paragraph 1 of the Patent Office action, it is admitted that it is immaterial whether signals are transmitted when both of coils 14-15 are energized and not transmitted when only one is energized or vice versa. The amendment to page 5 of the specification is directed to this matter.

Claims 1, 2, and 3 have been amended to specify that the second (enciphering) circuit of the claims is controlled by a second facsimile signal, thereby differentiating from Pierce, 1,312,574.

Claims 1, 2, 3, and 4 have also been amended to overcome the rejection for indefiniteness, all claims now including <u>switches</u> (rather than receivers) operated in either of two positions.

The amendment to Claim 8, pointing out that secrecy in the transmission is achieved by adding to the one signal a second facsimile transmission avoids Belin, 1,657,366, and Jenkins, 1,763,358,
the first of which patents provides variable speed signals from a single picture placed upon a drum revolving erratically rather than constantly, and the second of which patents utilizes a signal based on a succession of picture elements which are substantially displaced from each other instead of in normal continuity.

Reconsideration is requested.
