





SUBJECT: 

3. If the assumption made in the foregoing paragraph is correct, it is believed that this less sensitive sub-category of Category III should be established as one which, at the discretion of either party, could be handled normally without any special procedures or codewords. Thus, in order to avoid administrative and technical problems arising out of compartmentation procedures, USCIB, at least initially, would not designate or handle this material in a manner different from other TOP SECRET FROTH material.
