Subject: UK Procedure for clearance of COMSEC Release Proposals



1. The enclosed memorandum to the Director, NSA from the Washington Liaison Officer of the London Communication Security Agency (LCSA) is circulated for information at the request of the former.

2. It will be noted that the British arrangement for handling COMSEC releases corresponds very closely to the U.S. procedures enclosed with reference (a) and that the function of the Director, LCSA in such matters closely corresponds to that of the Director, NSA as set forth in reference (a) and in paragraph 2d. 12 of reference (b).

3. No action appears to be required of either USCSB or USCIB.
