

- 2. Formulate communication security policies in the following aspects:
 - a. Physical security of publications, documents, equipment and messages.
 - b. Transmission security.
 - e. Cryptographic security.
 - d. The interrelation of operational and communication security.
 - e. Training activities.
- 3. Make recommendations for the improvement or withdrawal from use of cryptographic systems and equipment as necessary for the maintenance of security.
- 4. Insure coordination with the Joint Intelligence Countities, Security Penal, whenever important policy considerations are involved affecting security.
