In a faceimile privacy apparatus, a first device for securing a subject, a lamp associated with said device the intensity of its illumination being varied responsive to the output of said device, a second device for scanning a subject consurrently with the first device the output of said second device acting on said lamp to vary the intensity of illumination thereof, and light sensitive means for previding a signal responsive to the illumination of said lamp.

12. In a faceinile privacy apparatus, a first device for sounding a subject, a lamp associated with said device the intensity of its illumination being varied responsive to the output of said device, a second device for sounding a subject concurrently with the first device the output of said second device acting on said lamp to vary the intensity of illumination thereof, light sensitive means for providing a signal responsive to the illumination of said lamp, another lamp and means for varying the intensity of its illumination in response to the output of said light sensitive means, another light sensitive means responsive to said other lamp, means for effectively subtracting from the output of said other light sensitive means a signal equivalent to the output of said other light sensitive means a signal equivalent to the output of said other device, and means for graphically recording the result.

15. The method of obtaining a private faceinile signal which includes varying a translating device in response to a signal from the subject to be transmitted and consumptibly varying the trans-

lating device by another signal.

Claim 4 has been amended to specify means for balancing the eutputs of the amplifying circuits. The claim as amended is believed to overcome the Examiner's rejection for indefiniteness.

New Claims 11, 12, and 13 are directed to apparatus and a method for obtaining privacy in faceinile communications through a sensept believed new with the applicants. Of the references cited, only Pierce, 1,312,574, embodies the addition of signals, and the "addition" of this patent consists of blocking out one of the signals. Applicants effectively add and subtract by means of bridge circuit 11-13, and apply the true sum or difference exarest to translating device 14.

Reconsideration is requested.
