The rejection of claims 13 and 14 is repeated. As at present advised, the process appears to be inseparably associated with the apparatus claimed. In claim 13 it should be further noted that enough steps have not been enumerated to produce the result claimed starting with "and deriving" on line 3.

Claim 15 is again rejected on Korn or Scherbius. The previous ground of rejection is unpatent-ability and not that the claims are fully met.

The rojection of claims 16 and 17 is repeated. In Hebern No. 1,683,072 elements 4 and 37 appear
to be keys and indicators arranged sufficiently adjacent
each other to render the claims not patentable.

Claims 18, 19, 22 and 23 appear allowable.

Claim 21; is again rejected as not complying with R. S. 1888. Cancellation is in order.

The remaining claims are canceled,
