1. I have burnt the wire you requested in your wire, and I sent all the material by secure means at the end of September. (Consult our wire #363<sup>°</sup>), and since, therefore, I have no material here, I cannot report. (?Because of the information contained in these documents?) and because I fear that documents in code may be scattered about in case we are bombed, I have established the custom of burning telegraphic texts and such documents after keeping them for about 2 months. Therefore please send requests for rewires, etc., as soon as possible.

As for the VICHY strip, it is a certainty that they have decrypted the items which I reported in Finland wires 299<sup>a</sup> and 406<sup>b</sup>. However, the present status of the work is unknown. But the man in charge of the work has said that subsequent work on the American codes is at a standstill.

Please understand that it is difficult to investigate the practical results in view of the existing conditions in this country as we reported in Finland wire  $#454^{\circ}$ .
