Army and Navy authorities at the Central Headquarters have decided to (?change?) the code. We expect perfect code security Hovever, --2U-- counter measures have numerous disadvantageous features.

Although the Central Headquarters is also investigating fundamental counter-weasures, we want you to pay immediate attention to the following points. We expect perfect code security. Please make absolutely certain that nothing occurs which would be harmful to our national welfare.

1. Make the rooms in which secret (?documents?) are received and kept always watched by JAPANESE. Furthermore, permit only JAPANESE to enter and leave these rooms.
