- 1. The Turkish Ambassador recently made a formal request to the Department of State for assistance in acquiring automatic cipher machines for use in communications between the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Turkish diplomatic representatives abroad. The request was referred for comment to the Director, Armed Forces Security Agency, through the U.S. Havy member of the State-Defense Military Information Control Committee (S-D MICC). A copy of the correspondence is attached as an emclosure.
- 2. Two cipher machines are currently authorized for NATO use, the British Typex, Hark II, and the Combined Cipher Machine, in both the U.S. and the British versions. The CCM will be provided for Turkish forces in NATO; therefore, the cryptographic principles of the CCM will be known to the Turkish government.
