Bear Pr. Potter:

I have devoted considerable time to studying the Special Commutations Advisory Group (SCAG) Report which was submitted to me on 17 March 1952 and which I found not only quite interesting but also very uneful.

The five principal recommendations made in the Amport have been given special attention and I have directed that those recommendations or parts of them which can be carried out as matters entirely within my responsibility are to be implemented without delay and to the maximum practicable degree.

I was favorably impressed with the recommendation that a separate research organisation be established within this Agency and was very glad that you have agreed to assist the special group which I have set up in the igency to prepare a plan for the establishment and operation of each a research organisation.

In my opinion the principal purpose for which 30% was associated has been successfully accomplished. That purpose was to look into one of the most important problems before this igency, to reader an opinion as to whether we are employing our resources to best advantage on the problem, and to recommend further action or steps which might hesten the solution. I feel confident that the recommendations contained in the 3000 meport will be conducted to that end.

Aside from the foregoing, mother important purpose was to equality estain top-flight mathematicisms and electronics engineers with our work and to evoke their interest in it so that we might call individually upon them for eccasional advice or assistance on certain aspects of our problems. I believe that this secondary aim has also been accomplished.
