- 1. I am pleased to learn from the reference that the projected study of the U.S. COMINT effort during the Korean conflict has your support. In view of the fact that the cryptologic agencies of the army and Air Force are preparing accounts of their COMINT operations as separate histories, it seems to se that it would be advantageous for the cryptologic agency of the Navy to produce a comparable account of the Navy COMINT effort. This would afford automorp to the Navy in the determination of the form and content of its history; it would also provide for uniformity in the execution of the project by all three Services.
- A. I would be glad to assist the Mavy in executing such a project. National Security Agancy assistance would take the form of making available to the Director of Maval Communications (DEC) the services of Communicr E. W. Messy and personnel subordinate to him, as well as the services of Lieutenant H. M. Moslin. Under this arrangement, Communior Managy would confer with Commander M. M. Gillespie and provide for the details of implementation. In this latter connection, Communior Managy would be authorized to make the services of one of his Maval officers who participated in the Mavy COMINT effort in the Morean theater available to DEC on a full-time basis as may be required. The other MAA personnel concerned would be authorized to devote sufficient time to the project to insure that their respective espabilities to contribute information are fully exploited.
- 3. Your concurrence in the plan outlined in paregraph 2 above is requested.
- 4. If the plan meets with your concurrence and is brought to completion, MAA would like to have 10 copies of the report.
